



## ***BILL SUMMARY***

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# **Reenrollment Coverage HF 552**

Status of Bill: House Calendar

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### **Background**

HF 552 was originally amended to apply solely to public sector health care plans. As amended in committee, it extends to all types of insurance coverages. Current Iowa law covers a dependent until they reach the age of 25, which does not match the Federal Law which covers until the age of 26.

### **Summary**

Currently a child who is 25 years or older who maintains full time status as a student in an accredited institution in a post-secondary education program is allowed a continuation of existing coverage or reenrollment. This bill would eliminate that provision.

### **Section 2**

Covers all public health care plans. There are currently 186 people covered under the provision which the bill eliminates. These are people who are on the State health insurance contract.

### **Section 3**

Covers an insurer issuing an individual policy.

### **Section 4**

Covers private employment coverage.

### **Applicability**

Applies to all plans delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed in Iowa on or after January 1, 2016.

### **Effective Date**

Takes effect January 1, 2016.
