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### Amendment Summary

#### H-8117 (Staed)

Adds HF 2180 which deals with extreme risk protective orders as Division I of the bill.

#### H-8102 (Lundgren)

- Changes a “may” to a “shall” when disclosing mental health information to a law enforcement agent.
- Adds a portion of the Senate bill regarding the definition of “seriously mental impaired.” Includes lack of compliance as part of the definition.
- Adds oral medication as an appropriate medication for a person who is in protective custody.
- Strikes the Adoption of Administrative Rules section-adds a new section specifying that DHS has to submit a notice of intended action no later than August 15, 2018, clarifies that the rules adopted should have minimal delay or disruption to services, specifies the requirements for the Access Centers, Assertive Community Treatment Teams and Intensive Residential Service Homes.
- Adds members to the Commitment Process Review Workgroup.
- Adds members to the Tertiary Care Workgroup.

#### H-8121 to H-8102 (Lundgren)

Clarifies that a commitment hearing may be held by video conference at the discretion of the court.

#### H-8118 (Isenhardt)

Adds HF 2211 that states funding services for people with substance-related disorders may be included in the annual service and budget plans for regions.
