Amendments

H-8429 by Tymeson (R) – Further identifies that mathematics curriculum must include algebra and higher mathematics and science curriculum must include biology, chemistry, and physics.

H-8428 by Alons (R) – Exempts a school from implementing core curriculum if 50% or more of their students enrolled had an average composite score on the most recent college admissions exam administered by the American college testing program higher than the state average combined score on the same test.

H-8378 – See previous summary

H-8434 by Raecker (R) – Strikes performance standards from requirements on amendment. Requires the task force to develop rigorous performance standards and requires the director of the department of education to provide an experienced staff person to assist the task force. Mandates mathematics, science, social studies, and art for kindergarten through sixth grade.

H-8390 by Raecker (R) – Mandates mathematics, science, social studies, and art for kindergarten through sixth grade.

H-8432 by Raecker, Tymeson, Chambers (R) and Dandekar, Huser, Bailey, Quirk, Kelley, Mertz, Wise (D) - Same as H-8378 with amendments H-8434 and H-8390 included.

H-8474 by Raecker (R) and Wise (D) – Changes the implementation date to 2014 instead of 2012, but encourages school districts to implement the rigorous core content standards prior to the June 30, 2014, date.
