Background

The original House File was filed by Rep. Jones due to a constituent concern. A local veterinarian attempted to hire a teenager to do laundry services after school. The permit was denied due to the current prohibition of minors being allowed to perform laundry occupations in lowa. The bill was amended in committee to its current form as HF 441.

Summary

House File 441 allows laundering occupations minors aged 16 and 17 years old. In addition, for 14 and 15 year olds laundering occupations are allowed if the washing machines have less than a 10 cubic feet capacity and the water temp does not go above 212 degrees F.
