Background

An official from the Attorney General's office reviewed Administrative Rules regarding the Board of Cosmetology, and determined that the Board did not have the authority to issue temporary permits for cosmetologists to provide services at not-for-profit events because these events were not held at brick and mortar cosmetologist locations. This language was taken out of Administrative Rules in January. It was stated that in order to have these permits, it would have to be done through the legislative process, and this language matches what was previously taken out.

Summary

HF 2488 allows for these temporary permits to be issued by the Board of Cosmetology. This permit has to be posted and visible to the public at the location where the services are being done. The temporary permit is only valid for 12 days, and an applicant must submit an application and fee to the Board at least 30 days before the date of the event. The fee is to be determined by the Board by rule. An applicant cannot receive more than four temporary permits in a calendar year.
