Summary

This legislation defines an "agricultural experience" as an agricultural related activity as secondary use that goes hand in hand with agricultural production, that takes place on a farm and is open to the public. The intended purpose must be promoting or educating the public about ag practices, activities, or products.

The legislation bans any county from requiring a conditional use permit, special use permit, special exception, or a variance for the agricultural experience on a property where the primary use is agricultural production.
