Summary

The bill allows for an emergency medical service provider, fire department, or law enforcement agency to donate used vehicles and equipment to an organization that provides fire response, emergency medical services, or a law enforcement agency.

As long as the entity is making a good faith donation they are immune from civil liability on any claim related to the performance, failure to perform, age, condition, nature, or packaging of the donated equipment or vehicle.

Amendment Summary

H-8040 by Isenhart of Dubuque

This amendment prevents the donation of equipment that contains perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance. The amendment also strikes the immunity language if donated equipment contains perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl.
